Exhibitor ID Requirements: All persons working in the Exhibit Hall must wear a conference badge at all times. All exhibitors will receive two "Exhibit Hall Only" badges. Merchandise Sales: Exhibitors may sell merchandise from booths during the exhibit hours of the conference. The Renaissance Harborplace Hotel prohibits the sale of alcohol, food, beverage or tobacco products.
